

Student Council Minutes (meeting was on 9/21/05)

Attendance was taken. Jonathan Dunn moved that the minutes be postponed until next meeting because Emily Rudman had left them in another folder. Ian seconded, and the motion passed. Mohit gave the Treasurer's Report. Our new balance is \$7,482.33. Emily read the Thank You note the council received from St. Anne's for their donation of \$450. Brandi and Laura will sell donuts this Friday (9/23). Gregor and Adil will sell donuts the following Friday. Dave Hartmann was announced as the senior class choice for the new Senior Class Council Representative. Judith moved to accept Dave as a new member to the council, Clif seconded, and the motion passed. Ashley inducted Dave, and everyone clapped. Judith announced that Chad will be the new Senior Class Secretary. Ashley gave the second reading of the Mock Trial Team. Jonathan Dunn moved to approve the club, Michael seconded, and the motion passed. Jonathan Biberstine gave the Council Evaluations report. He announced that Registration received a rating of 7 out of 10. The process of registration went well, but several students complained about the quality of their ID picture due to the new camera. The New Student Luncheon received an 8.5 out of ten. Both new and old students enjoyed the event, but one new student complained that the cafeteria was too small of a site. MORP was given a rating of 6 out of ten due to complaints about too much rap music and the lack of a picture area for couples. Chad gave the report that no other clubs in the school were planning on doing a fundraiser for the victims of Hurricane Katrina. Chelsea March told the council that the Homecoming parade line up is at 6:00 pm on Friday (9/23) in the Cumberland parking lot. The parade will begin at 6:15 and end at the High School Sports Complex. All council members were urged to help clean up Spirit Week decorations after school on Friday (9/23). Welcoming, Spirit, and Activities committees were told that they need to write a report about their respective events for next year's committee heads. All of the freshman Council members, except for Augusto, volunteered to pass out boom sticks before the game on Friday (9/23). Judith announced that the Constitutional Revisions committee made a change in the Council Constitution. Previously, Article IV: Elections stated, "In the case of resignation, impeachment, or removal of a Student Council or class officer or representative, the Vice-President/Treasurer shall replace the President." Now the constitution here states, "In the case of resignation, impeachment, or removal of the President of the Student Council, the Vice-President/Treasurer shall replace the President." Brian moved to allot \$2000 to put on The Hypnotist convocation, Ian seconded, and the motion passed. Clif presented blue sheets for the sophomore class to put on a Rat Trap, the Junior Prom Board to have a garage sale, the Cheerleaders to sell handmade soap, WeSSO to collect donations to help cure breast cancer, and for Pep Club to hold Penny Wars to promote school spirit. Clif moved that each of these blue sheets be passed, Ian seconded, and the motion passed. Clif moved that we adjourn, Brian seconded, and the motion passed.
